## STUDENTS COUNCIL ELECTION - 2025

After the presentation phase, students participated in the voting process to elect their representatives. Each student had the chance to cast their vote for the candidate they believed who would best serve the interests of their house and contribute positively to the school environment. Students can nominate themselves to run for a post in the student council, given that they fulfill the following general eligibility criteria.

School elections are held annually and shall be conducted within six weeks from the start of the academic session. The entire election process, from the date of filing nomination papers, campaigning, and declaration of the results, should not exceed 10 days.

After a fair and transparent voting process, the results were tallied, and the schoolhouse leaders for both boys and girls were elected. The newly elected leaders are expected to work closely with school authorities, teachers, and fellow students to address issues, organize activities, and represent the student body effectively.
