## INDOOR GAME :- CARROM BOARDS



## PREPOSITION ACTIVITIES FOR OUR GRADE-1 KIDS



Preposition activities for our grade-1 kids include interactive games like "Simon Says" and "Follow the Instruction," creative exercises like building a "Preposition Book" or going on a scavenger hunt, and simple hands-on tasks like placing a toy in different locations. These activities use movement, objects, and stories to help children understand and use words that show position, direction, and time, such as in, on, under, behind, and next to.

## GRADE 4 FRACTION ACTIVITIES



Grade 4 fraction activities should focus on hands-on and visual concepts like creating fraction walls with paper strips, playing with fraction-based games like "Fraction Goal," and using craft materials like paper plates to build and compare parts of a whole. More advanced activities include comparing fractions using visual aids like pie charts, finding equivalent fractions, and solving word problems involving the four basic operations of fractions.

A game board with fractions is used. Students land on a spot and must simplify a given fraction to find a matching spot on the board to win.

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
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## ENGLISH GRADE 8 GRAMMAR PROJECT
