## SCI: THE NEWTON DISC



Class 7: Students with The Newton disc, or "disappearing colour disc," is a physics, demonstration, and, or project featuring a wheel with seven colored segments—red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet (ROYGBIV)—that appears white when spun rapidly. It demonstrates that white light is composed of these seven colors, utilizing the persistence of vision to mix the colors.

## MODEL OF HELIUM ATOM:

## SCI: MODEL OF ATOM



Grade 9 Nishanth Kumar presented the model of the atom, which has evolved from solid, indivisible spheres (Dalton) to the modern quantum mechanical cloud model. Key historical models include Thomson's

Thomson's "plum pudding" (positive sphere with embedded electrons), Rutherford's nuclear model (dense positive nucleus with orbiting electrons), and Bohr's model (electrons in fixed energy shells).

## INDIA POLITICAL MAP ACTIVITY FOR GRADE 3




