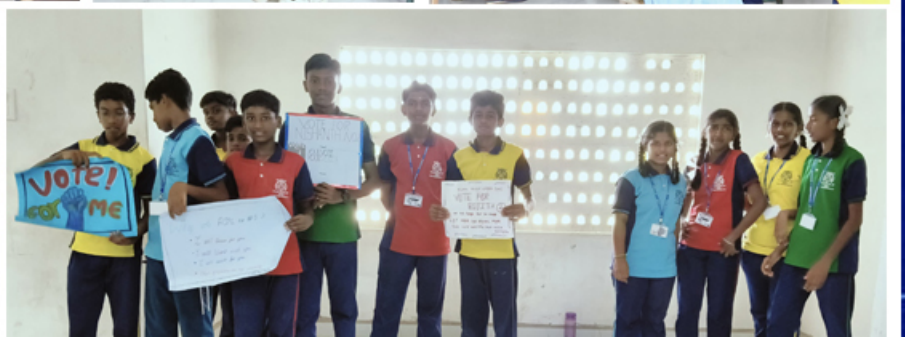
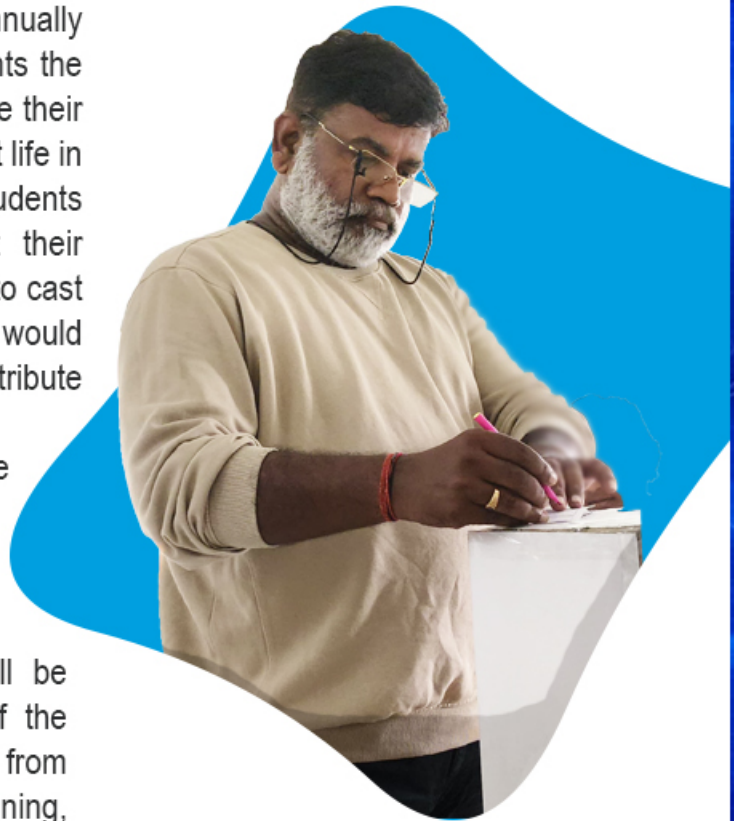

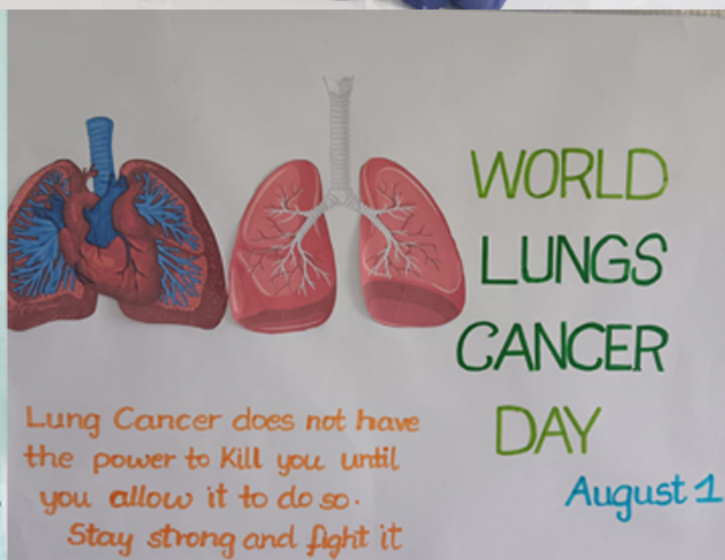
# WORLD LUNG CANCER DAY AWARENESS PROGRAM

Their innocent words and stage presence won the hearts of teachers. The competition proved to be a great learning experience for the students and gave them a platform to explore their hidden talents.

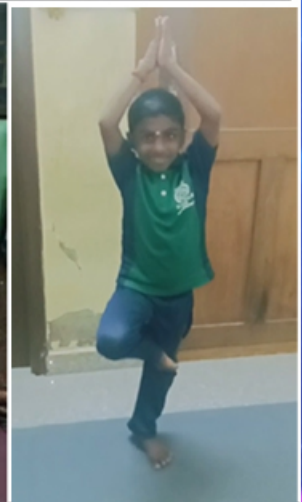

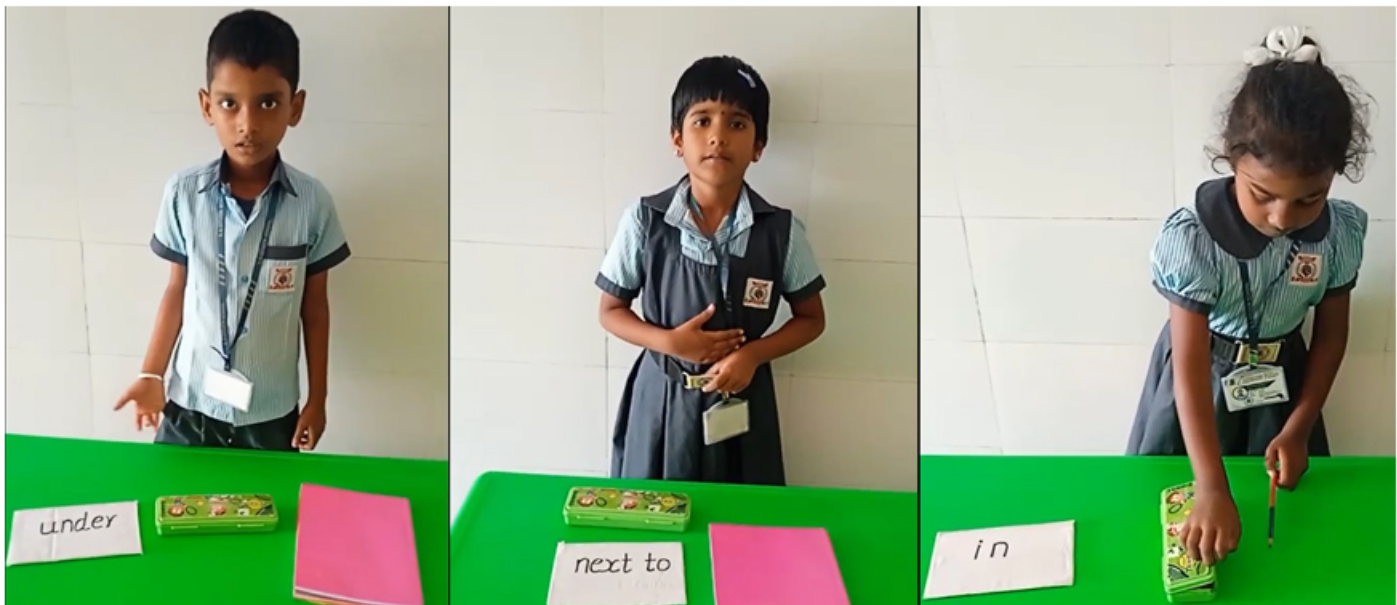

The celebration served as a meaningful reminder of the founder's values, dedication, and lasting contribution to education and society.

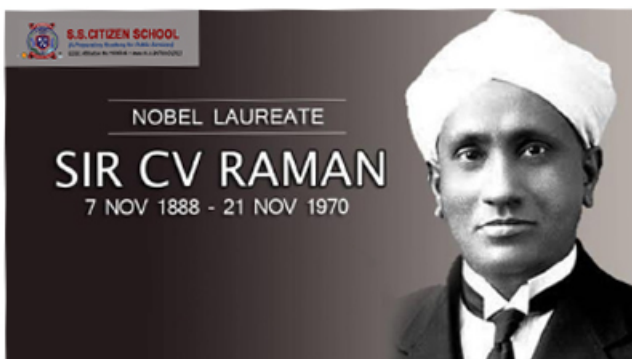
# INTERNATIONAL FOREST DAY CELEBRATED.

## GOVERNMENT IS AN ORGANIZATION



In a student presentation, government is defined as the system, group of people, or organization authorized to make decisions, create laws, and enforce order within a

Class 7: Students with The Newton disc, or "disappearing colour disc," is a physics, demonstration, and, or project featuring a wheel with seven colored segments—red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet (ROYGBIV)—that appears white when spun rapidly. It demonstrates that white light is composed of these seven colors, utilizing the persistence of vision to mix the colors.

The Newton Disc is a simple and interesting science experiment that demonstrates that white light is a combination of seven rainbow colours. When the disc spins rapidly, our eyes blend the colours together, making the disc appear white.

Class 6: Students with a water cycle project involves moving beyond simple diagrams to more complex, hands-on demonstrations that incorporate scientific variables and documentation.

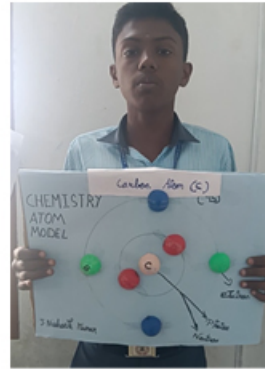

quantum mechanical cloud model. Key historical models include Thomson's. Thomson's "plum pudding" (positive sphere with embedded electrons), Rutherford's nuclear model (dense positive nucleus with orbiting electrons), and Bohr's model (electrons in fixed energy shells).
