## CLASS 6 COLOURFUL CLAY PLANET-MAKING ACTIVITY



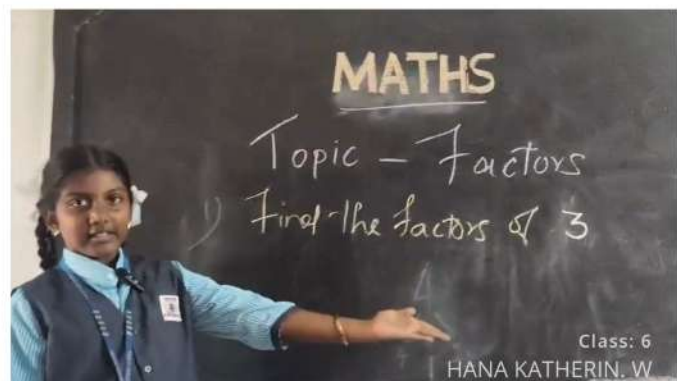
